Brief Resume

Cary A. Presant, M.D., F.A.C.P., a hematologist and medical oncologist, is a staff physician at Wilshire Oncology Medical Group. He has been involved in laboratory and clinical investigations, and has served as director of cancer programs at Washington University School of Medicine, the Jewish Hospital of St. Louis and the City of Hope National Medical Center in Los Angeles, California. He is currently Professor of Clinical Medicine at the University Of Southern California School Of Medicine, and is the Chairman of the Los Angeles Cancer Institute, St. Vincent Medical Center. He is presently Director of Medical Oncology for DiaTech Oncology. Dr. Presant's current research in West Covina, California, and at the Los Angeles Cancer Institute is focused on aromatase inhibitor therapy of breast cancer, pharmacologic improvement of chemotherapy effectiveness by magnetic resonance spectroscopy, and the development of new therapeutic programs for cancer. He is the author of over 400 scientific articles and is a recognized expert in cancer treatment, cancer detection, chemotherapy, experimental tumor biology and pharmacology, liposomes for cancer diagnosis and therapy, magnetic resonance spectroscopy, measurement of quality of life in cancer patients, and quality care in oncology. As an author, Dr. Presant has written "Navigating American Medicine", soon to be published, is the physician columnist for the national website "HealthNews.com," and is a contributor to the San Marino Tribune and Beverly Hills Courier. Dr. Presant is past president of the California Division of the American Cancer Society. A past president and founder of the Medical Oncology

Association of Southern California, he is currently the Chairman of the Board of Directors. Nationally, Dr. Present is a past Director of the American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO), and received the Statesman award of ASCO in 2007. He served as President of the Association of Community Cancer Centers (ACCC) from 2002 - 2003. He was honored as one of the "Best Doctors in America". Because of his commitment to early diagnosis of cancer, Dr. Present was appointed by Fran Drescher to the Board of Directors of her charitable organization Cancer Schmancer. From 2004 until the present, Dr. Present has co-chaired the national Oncology Congress. Dr. Present was born in Buffalo, New York. He received his medical degree in 1966 from the State University of New York at Buffalo, and completed postdoctoral training at Columbia University in New York City, the National Cancer Institute in Bethesda, Maryland, and Washington University School of Medicine in St. Louis, Missouri.
