Mr. Latimer it has been months since I corresponded with you. It has been 14 1/2 months since Bill's PET scan that determined the lung cancer. We lost precious weeks, about 12 due to the negligence (and I feel this was a disservice to us) of the physician who saw Bill and ordered the PET scan. This was done on April 1 or 2nd, and we did not hear from him for almost 4 weeks. Then he ordered a breathing test which took another four weeks to be scheduled and read, and then another visit to his PCP who recommended the axillary lymph node biopsy which brought us to August when we actually knew definitely that Bill had lung cancer stage 4 with metastasis to the lymph nodes. They wanted us to use T. O. and actually scheduled an appointment for Bill for consultation. In the meantime, Jeff met you and the rest you know. In early August he had another lymph node biopsy at Baptist (as you know) and you took that specimen and recommended the treatment protocol for Bill. Dr. Rogers has been wonderful to us. He is thorough and not many weeks after the chemotherapy was started there was improvement in the chest x-ray. One of the drugs used in the chemotherapy was more toxic than the other two. I cannot remember the name of it but you would know as it was on your recommendations. Bill was deathly ill during the time the first 3 drugs were used. He lost from 191 down to the 150s. He acquired Pseudomonas from some source and we almost lost him as the doctors related this to me. He bounced back and his x-rays continued to improve. There has been no evidence of lymph node swelling or evidence of them being palpable anywhere in his body. He has developed a "foot dropsy" of the right foot. A brain scan was scheduled to assess metastasis to the brain. None was found and now that problem is almost gone. About 8 or 9 weeks into his chemotherapy he woke up one morning with a voice above a whisper. Dr. Rogers told us that he felt this was due to the disease affecting the recurrent laryngeal nerve and did not feel his voice would come back to any degree. After several weeks of this we asked Dr. Rogers to refer us to a speech therapist and we pursued that course. The speech therapist recommended an ENT consultation. We pursued that (Dr. Speyer at Skyline) He did a test by looking at Bill's throat through the nasal cavity and told recommended a Strobe Light test at Vanderbilt. We pursued that and it showed that his left vocal cord was not functioning (partially paralyzed) and the ENT, after looking at the video recommended surgery to inject that vocal cord with a substance (I think it must work on the order of Botox, but I do not know what the substance was. It was to gel and become firm in the vocal cord allowing the vocal cords to meet and therefore restore some of his voice. That was done on June 8 and we are in a 2-week course of complete voice rest and he will revisit the ENT in two weeks to see how this surgery has worked. This is where we are at this point. We can only hope and pray that he will have some semblance of a voice after all of

this.

Bill feels good. He has regained his weight up to 171 pounds and Dr. Rogers says this is a good weight and not to be worried about gaining more. He goes about his daily work, mowing the grass, studying and getting his sermons up and he had been preaching up until three weeks ago using a powerful microphone. But after the tests and surgery he is not to do this again until he is released from the ENT.

We thank you for your wonderful service to us and all those that use your company to ascertain the best treatment for the different cells of cancer.

We will never forget you and your generosity shown us. If we can help promote you and your company in any way just call us and we will do whatever you need us to do. We feel that you were a Godsend to Jeff and eventually to us. We give God the praise but we praise God for people like you and your lab.
